During the January Board of Directors (BOD) meeting the various committee met and furthered their work on the strategic objectives of NASN.

The BOD spent one day of the meeting on Capitol Hill visiting many of our Senators and Representatives and/or their staff to promote NASN's three legislative priorities for the year:

1. Support and promote the Prevention and Public Health Fund, established by the Affordable Care Act, which creates a healthier, more sustainable future for our nation's children,
2. Encourage the US Department of Education to prevent and address teen dating violence, which is an increasing public health and education concern, and
3. Urge Congress to re-introduce legislation, the Student-to-School Nurse Ratio Improvement Act, which recognizes the critical role school nurses serve in providing access to quality care.
